Are you looking for a challenge and an opportunity to make a difference in South Africa? We need an energetic leader to head up the National Association of Social Housing Organisations (NASHO) as General Manager

NASHO is a federation of non-profit Social Housing Institutions (SHIs) that develops and/or manages social housing in South Africa. We are a non-profit organisation registered as a voluntary association. Our primary objective is to ensure the development of a strong and sustainable social housing sector in South Africa. To achieve this, we act as Facilitator, Expert, Advocate and Trainer working with all role-players in the sector.

We are financed primarily through our membership fees which is complimented by fees for rendering professional services such as research, training, capacity building.

The General Manager takes overall responsibility for managing all NASHO's activities.

What you will be doing:

You will work closely with the NASHO National Executive Committee to plan NASHO's programme and engage key sector stakeholders (the Social Housing regulator, local municipalities and provincial government officials) to advocate for social housing.

You will be the key role player in planning, implementing, monitoring and reporting on NASHO's programmes. These programmes include training interventions, capacity development, research, and policy development. You will manage the NASHO office, staff and consultants.

The ideal personality:

You must be able to get things done, when they need to be done. You will need to be experienced enough to know which parts of your job need to be prioritised. You will be an excellent communicator and advocate, able to adapt to your audience. As the successful incumbent, you will balance a breadth of technical experience and knowledge with an ability to manage people and projects.

Skills and qualifications:

- A Bachelor's degree.
- 5 years' management experience in a non-profit or public sector organization.
- Knowledge of the Social Housing sector in South Africa.
- Experience in fundraising, financial management and people management.
- Experience with advocacy or with public policy making will be advantageous.
- Ability to work productively and flexibly without large support infrastructure.

Preference will be given to Historically Disadvantaged Individuals.
